# Disposition of Animals After Purchase

## 1) Resale

- The fair will sell the animal at market price.
- Monterey County Fair will bill the buyer for the difference.

## 2) Slaughter

- Buyers wishing their purchase custom processed will designate one of the meat processing plants shown on the previous page to which the animal is to be delivered.
- Please indicate a second choice as well. The fair will arrange the killing, including delivery to one of the three companies designated by the buyer.

## Conditions of Sale

1. Payment will be accepted on the Day of the Sale.
2. Buyer's total balance will be due and payable to Monterey County Fair, Junior Livestock Auction within 30 days
  - After 30 days, interest will be charged at 1.5% per month, (18% APR) on unpaid balances
  - After 60 days a \$20.00 late fee plus 1.5% interest on unpaid balances
  - After 90 days collection action will be taken, plus late fees and interest on unpaid balances.
  - Junior Livestock Auction buyers must pay invoices in full for purchases made at the annual Monterey County Fair by December 31st of the year purchased or buyer will not be allowed to purchase or request add-ons for an animal at the following year's fair.
3. Any animal bought and the said buyer has outstanding money due from past years must pay at the time of purchase or animal will be resold immediately or the next highest bidder will have first option for said animal.
4. Monterey County Fair will bill all accounts that have prior credit approval.
5. All accounts that are billed will be charged according to the conditions of the sale.
6. Bump Bids will be accepted until 5 PM day of the sale. Bump bids are additional moneys added to an exhibitor's seller check. This amount is not a part of the original purchase. Anyone wishing to add a bump bid must complete the appropriate paperwork and submit not later than 5 PM day of sale.
