



## **Monterey County Fair Exhibit Receiving & Release Protocols**

In accordance with State and local Government Authorities, the following steps have been taken to prevent further spread of COVID-19. Your safety and health is our priority.

Sick employees and volunteers must stay home.

Any employee and/or volunteer displaying symptoms will be sent home immediately.

Coughs and sneezes are to be covered.

Frequent handwashing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds is expected.

Personal protective equipment is required, this includes face coverings and where appropriate, gloves.

### **IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR EXHIBITORS:**

Face masks are required.

Exhibits may **ONLY** be dropped off on Saturday, August 22<sup>nd</sup> between 10 AM – 5 PM at the Monterey Room. Volunteers will be curbside for pick up **OR** put their mask on and stand in our socially distant line for entry receiving at the double doors facing the street. Driving through Gate 4 for drop off is prohibited.

Exhibits can be picked up on Tuesday, September 8<sup>th</sup> from Noon – 6:00 PM in the exact same place. We will have curbside delivery to the vehicle as well.

Exhibits will **NOT** be received in the administration office at any time.

Masks must be worn by anyone who exits their vehicle.

The protocols listed above also apply for exhibit release dates.
