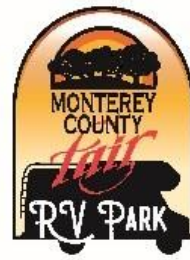


MONTEREY COUNTY FAIR RV PARK

COVID-19 RESPONSE PLAN



In accordance with State and local Government Authorities, the following steps have been taken to prevent further spread of COVID-19. Your safety and health is our priority. Our protocol is as follows:

Based on Cal/OSHA and CDC recommendations, the following guidelines and restrictions have been implemented for all Staff:

Sick employees must stay home.

Any employee displaying symptoms will be sent home immediately.

Coughs and sneezes are to be covered.

“High touch” surfaces are frequently cleaned with disinfectant.

Frequent handwashing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds is expected.

Personal protective equipment is required, this includes face coverings and where appropriate, gloves.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR GUESTS:

Face masks are required for office entry.

Please:

Do not enter facility if you are sick, have a cough, or a fever.

Maintain a 6 - foot distance from other guests.

Do not shake hands.

Wash your hands frequently.

Follow signage regarding social distance and sanitation.

Use hand sanitizer regularly.
