### **DEPARTMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- Entries limited to exhibitors located in Monterey, Santa Cruz, and San Benito Counties ONLY. See Junior Livestock Department Rules, Entry Information.
- 2. **Market Rabbits:** Limit of two (2) meat pen entries per Exhibitor. **Breed and Fur Rabbits:** Per State Rules, exhibitors may not earn more than two (2) cash prizes per class.
- 3. A Meat Pens shall consist of three (3) rabbits. No extra rabbits will be allowed onto the Fairgrounds to be added to a pen if the original pen does not meet weight requirements.
- 4. The Junior Market Rabbit Meat Pen show is a TERMINAL show for the Top 5 placing pens. The top 5 Rabbit Meat Pens selected by the judge shall remain on Fairgrounds and be sold during the Junior Livestock Auction.
- 5. Rules, definitions, and judging procedures as prescribed in the latest edition of the Guidebook and Standard of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. shall apply to all District and County Fair rabbit shows, provided they do not conflict with any rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture.
- 6. Breed and Fur Rabbits must have a legible, permanent number, symbol, letter, or series of either or both tattooed in its left ear, which must correspond with those on the online entries.
- 7. Duplication of ear markings by one exhibitor in the same Breed and Class will not be allowed. Entries with duplicate ear numbers will have one of those rabbits eliminated. The entry fee will not be returned.
- 8. Breed and Fur Rabbits will be shown and judged in divisions recognized by the ARBA.
- 9. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to take the rabbit to the show table when the class is called for it to be judged. Exhibitors may be assisted by other eligible members showing at the 2024 Monterey County Fair.
- 10. The exhibitor is to check the show cards at the beginning of the Rabbit Show and report any discrepancies to the Show Secretary immediately. No changes will be allowed during the show. Substitutions can only be made within the same division, sex variety, and class. This must be received in writing five days prior to the show date.

- 11. Breed and Fur Rabbits: Pedigree papers or a Bill of Sale showing the required ownership period (30 days) may be used instead of a pedigree if ear number and other required entry information are shown on the Bill of Sale. This should be available upon request the day of the show.
- 12. It is Exhibitor's responsibility to care for, feed, and water the rabbits.
- 13. Exhibitors shall maintain clean, dry bedding for their entries.
- 14. An Exhibitor participating in Junior Livestock Auction may purchase a Livestock Exhibitor Wristband for \$30.00. Exhibitors participating in Junior Livestock Auction are required to always have animals on grounds and are responsible for cleaning, feeding, and caring for these animals.
- 15. **Showmanship is NOT Mandatory for rabbit exhibitors.** Pre-entry is required for Showmanship if you choose to participate.
- 16. Pre-entry for Showmanship is Mandatory. Animal used in showmanship MUST belong to Exhibitor and be entered in one of the Breed and Fur Rabbits Divisions. Highest placing 4-H Junior, 4-H Senior, and FFA Senior showmen advance to Round Robin.
- 17. **Showmanship Attire**: As part of the official organization uniform, Exhibitors must wear a long-sleeved shirt or blouse.
- 18. **PRIMARY LEVEL**: Must be 5 years old as of December 31, 2023, to exhibit at Fair. Youth must be a registered 4-H member. Ribbons only. No premiums. Primary Membership ends when a youth qualifies as Junior Member.
- 19. ALL Junior Livestock Exhibitors at Monterey County Fair must enter at least one (1) non-perishable non-livestock still project for exhibit in this year's Fair. All still projects must be entered and delivered on their specific dates. NO LIVESTOCK PROJECTS WILL BE ACCEPTED IF THIS RULE IS NOT MET. ANIMALS WILL BE SENT HOME. NO EXCEPTIONS. All other rules in the Entry Guidebook apply.

- 1. Follow all applicable Departmental and General rules.
- 2. 4-H and FFA Divisions will show together.
- 3. The Junior Market Rabbit Meat Pen show is a TERMINAL show for the Top 5 placing pens. The top 5 Rabbit Meat Pens selected by the judge shall remain on Fairgrounds and be sold during the Junior Livestock Auction.
- 4. Exhibitors must enter at least one (1) non-livestock still project for exhibit in this year's Fair. See Junior Livestock Department Rules, Entry Information.
- 5. Limit two (2) meat pen entries per Exhibitor.
- 6. Market Rabbits minimum weight 3.5 lbs. each, maximum weight 5.5 lbs. each. Not over 70 days old.
- 7. All Market Rabbit breeds judged together. Each entry to be one breed and color.
- Market Rabbit entries eligible for Auction must be clean or they will not be allowed to sell.
