DEPARTMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. ALL Sheep must have Scrapie Tags.
- 2. Muzzling of any animals is prohibited.
- 3. MARKET & FEEDER LAMBS must be clipped to have less than ¹/₄ inch of fleece at weigh in.
- 4. Ewes entered in Market or Feeder Lamb Divisions may not be entered in Breeding Divisions or vice versa. Any violation of this rule will exclude offending exhibitors from competition in all Departments of the Fair.
- 5. **BREEDING SHEEP:** PERMANENT EAR TAG OR TATTOO IS REQUIRED AND MUST BE SUBMITTED ON ONLINE ENTRY.
- 6. **BRED & FED:** Open to market lambs entered the MCF Sheep Show. The class is only for animals that were born, raised, and finished in Monterey County. Entries must show proof of being born, raised, and finished in Monterey County. Exhibitors need not own sire or dam of market animal but must show written proof or affidavit of purchase from a Monterey County producer stating where the lamb was born and raised. All exhibitors will show together, and animals judged must be MARKET READY to win a class or place.
- 7. Pre-entry for Bred & Fed is mandatory for anyone eligible and wishing to participate.
- 8. **FEEDER ANIMALS:** All breeds will be judged together. **FEEDERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR SALE AT AUCTION.**
- 9. **Showmanship is Mandatory** for all Livestock Market Animal Exhibitors.
- 10. **CARCASS CONTEST:** All Market Lambs sold through the MCF Junior Livestock Auction will be evaluated for the Carcass Contest.

DEPARTMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. **MARKET GOATS** must be groomed and bathed and arrive in show condition.
- 2. Does entered in the Market or Feeder Meat Goat Divisions may not be entered in the Breeding Divisions or vice versa. Any violation of this rule will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all Departments of the Fair.
- 3. All breeds will be judged together.
- 4. Goats must be disbudded or dehorned; no horns allowed.
- 5. BRED & FED: Open to market goats entered in the MCF Market Goat Show. The class is only for animals that were born, raised, and finished in Monterey County. Entries must show proof of being born, raised, and finished in Monterey County. Exhibitors need not own sire or dam of market animal but must show written proof or affidavit of purchase from a Monterey County producer stating where the goat was born and raised. FFA, 4-H, and Independents will show together, and animals judged must be MARKET READY to win class or place.
- 6. **FEEDER ANIMALS:** All breeds will be judged together. **FEEDERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR SALE AT AUCTION**.
- 7. **Showmanship is Mandatory** for all Livestock Market Animal Exhibitors.
- 8. Pre-entry for Bred & Fed is mandatory for anyone eligible and wishing to participate.
